Please be in prayer for one of our students whose name is Denchu and his family. He has been informed that his mother is severely ill and is in the hospital and also that his sister has “bone cancer.” The reports for both of them put survival as doubtful.

Danny, one of our part time students for many years and an elder in a local church, while working on our campus jumped down from a wall and landed wrong requiring multiple rods to be installed in his ankle area. Pray for his quick recovery.

Biju, a graduate and local pastor/elder who I mentioned previously, is recovering after his fall and broken pelvis (among other things). The rehabilitation is slow and painful, and he needs our prayers.
